Notes:

1. The "Responsible Entity" is responsible for providing an accurate (CWD). This is usually the person in Australia who engages the road carrier or offers the container for transport by road in Australia
2. Including details of the packer enables easy identification of the person who packed the container. The packer could also be the "responsible entity"
3. Separating the weight of the container and it's contents ensures there is no confusion as to whether the declared weight is a net weight or a gross weight.
4. This enables the person who is relying on the (CWD) to determine it's likely accuracy.
5. CWD details could be included in another document (eg) the Export Pre-Receipt Advice (PRA), or provided separately

The contents of the (CWD) must be readily available to an authorized officer or police officer who seeks to ascertain it's contents, there and then in the presence of the container (whether by examining documents located on or in the vehicle or by obtaining the information by radio or mobile or other means)
